

# Your library's lists float to the top


Lists from other libraries appear below, highlighting the lists your staff have created.




#### List of lists

You can create a "list of lists" through a list search.

- 1) Search for lists in the "Lists" dropdown
- 2) Click "Add to list"
- View your list of lists in your account, under "Lists"






#### **Format order**

We now have the ability to customize the format order in grouped works.

The current order was set by the Discovery & User Experience Group.





You can still purchase and integrate Novelist Select on a per library basis, if you wish.






You may also like appears in Checked Out Titles in My Account


Both now just show titles at your library






### **New Series Searching**











#### **Duplication of series titles**








A "Spotify Wrapped" for your library!

Came out at the end of 2024, and we expect to see more fun things added for 2025.




# **Improvements for Library Staff**

- Save filters



### App Header


You can add your logo and a background color in your app.



# Scan-and-Go (Self check)

Symphony API integration was added in 2025.

This is still in testing, with three libraries piloting, but we expect it will be ready by the end of the year.



## **Bug fixes**

#### **Aspen Discovery (Web Catalog)**

- Fixes for CloudLibrary, Boundless, and OverDrive/Libby
- Accessibility updates for filters

#### Aspen LiDA (Mobile App)

- Fix for frequent logouts on unstable networks
  - App saves your barcode if you are logged out
- Accessibility fix for large type settings

#### **Stability**

SWAN changed hosting and support providers in March 2025.


- Incidents of bots and DDoS attacks is significantly lower
- Continue to deal with bots, but we get a much faster response with little downtime
- Catalog performance is much faster, with more improvements to come



# View all of your library's public lists

Helpful for cleaning up lists, seeing lists made in different staff accounts – or seeing what another library is up to!


Do an empty search limited to Lists, and filter.





# Add a list description

A nice way to give attribution to staff creating lists, or identify your library's lists more easily.



# Use preferred name if you have two cards

Two cards with the same name can be confusing in the app and catalog – use the preferred name feature to help you!


Also a helpful tip for patrons with same names in a family (Jr., etc.)

Keep in mind this will appear on notices as well.



# Integrate your events calendar

Then add it as a browse category!





# Add a logo and background to your app

"Logo to show above the screen title in LiDA"

"Header logo background color"

Setting is in Aspen Administration > Themes > Aspen LiDA




# Use the carousel browse category display

"Accessible Layout"

It is a tiny checkbox!





# Consider Aspen purchase suggestions

It takes some set up and there's a bit of a learning curve, but it is worth it especially if you get a lot of requests!

- Patrons see purchase suggestions in their account, so they can track them
- Staff can track suggestions through the Aspen Administration interface
- You can now place holds for purchases
- You can check if a title is already in the catalog
- Aspen will generate handy reports

Open a ticket to request purchase suggestions!

#### Update your ecommerce vendor

Aspen supports many e-commerce platforms.

It does not support multiple payment options (i.e you have to pick one).

- PayPal
  - Using your own PayPal instance allows you to issue refunds
- SnapPay
- Square
- Stripe
- Illinois ePay (in testing)






### Aspen events module

Pilot for interested libraries, anticipated in early 2026




# Redesign of the grouped work display

Anticipated 2026 – development is looking for funding




### Additional options for the LiDA home screen

# Push notifications in the app

Anticipated sometime in 2026

Currently works for Koha, Aspen developers are adding additional ILSes.

- Send users a phone alert when they have a hold ready
- Manual alerts are already available in the app (closings, etc.)

### We also have our eyes on...

These have no firm timeline yet

- Hoopla Flex integration for consortiums
- Better handling of abridged editions
- Better title/author keyword searches
- Better handling of special characters in a title (#, +)
- Nicer display of full author name
- Ability to group CD + Book with a book
- Improvements to lists, including:
  - Drag-and-drop
  - Additional sorting options
  - Easier printing
