KEY ACCESS METHODS



AUTHENTICATION METHODS

IP

- Allows users seamless access if they are on-site

SAML Single Sign On (SSO)

- OpenAthens

In progress

Geolocation

- Allows users in a particular geographical area to access resources seamlessly
- Use of geolocation authentication is restricted to organizations that provide access to all users in the area – for example, all users in their state

What is SWAN using?

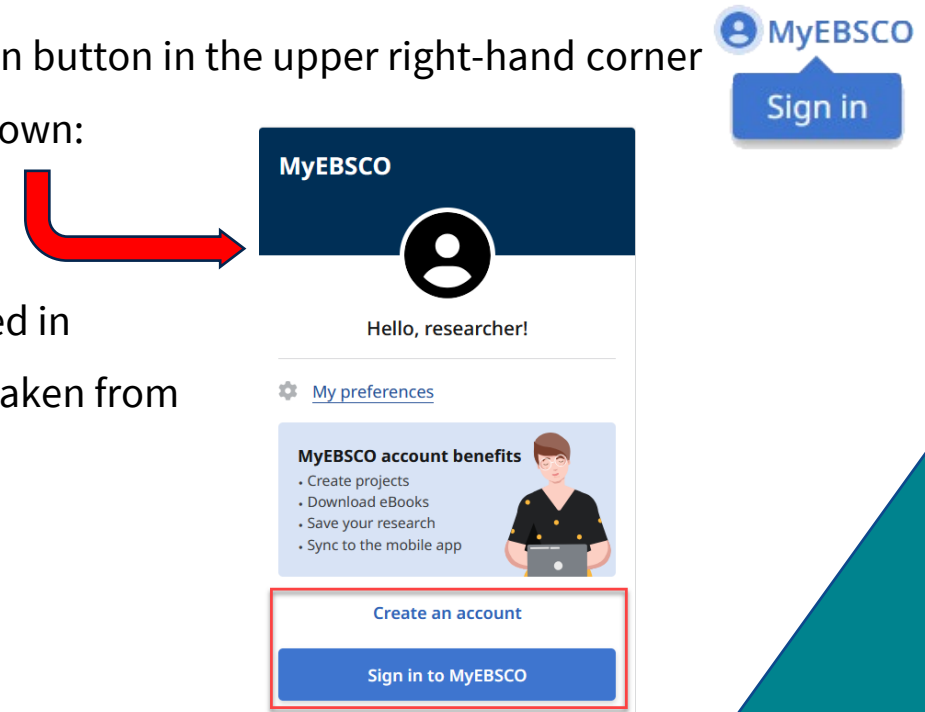
- A combination of both IP and SAML – identified by the “authtype=ip,shib” portion of a URL
 - Allows one link to identify whether the patron is inside the library (using IP address) or if the patron is remote (using OpenAthens)
- Additional methods can be added as necessary

PERSONAL ACCOUNTS

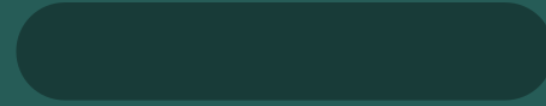
- Allows patrons to create a MyEBSCO account
- MyEBSCO accounts can be used to save and manage research
- Not required to do research, but required if patrons wishes to save anything beyond the current session
- Works across all EBSCO interfaces

How they work

- Once a patron is granted access to the EBSCO database, there is a sign-in button in the upper right-hand corner
- Patron can click the **Sign in** button, and the following options will be shown:
 - **Create an account**
 - **Sign in to MyEBSCO**
- Create an account will go through OpenAthens to ensure patron is signed in
- Patron can further customize by adding their full name, but barcode is taken from the OpenAthens login
 - Same instructions for both on-site and remote access



ESSENTIAL FEATURES



NEW USER INTERFACE – MY DASHBOARD

- Available in EBSCOhost, EBSCO Discovery Service (EDS), and Explora profiles
- Located in the left column or the left-hand navigation menu
- Projects, Saved Items, Searches, items you've viewed, and alerts
- Dashboard is collapsible
- Unless the patron has signed into their MyEBSCO account, anything in this dashboard will be lost once they end the session

NEW USER INTERFACE – RESEARCH TOOLS

Publication Finder

Removeable

- Primarily for finding and accessing specific e-journals and e-books
- Allows patrons to search publications by title, browse alphabetically, and filter by database or subject
- Helps patrons identify if a particular publication is available online through their institution's subscriptions

Additional settings available

Publications Authority

Removeable

- Establishes and manages authorized headings for publications within a database
- Creates and maintains authoritative records for publications, including preferred titles, authorized access points, and subject headings
- Ensures consistency and accuracy in how publications are referenced and indexed within the database
- Managing bibliographic data and ensuring proper identification and organization of publications

Subjects Authority

Removeable









- Helps patrons discover the specific subject terms used in EBSCO databases. Useful because it allows users to find the most relevant terms for their research and ensures they are using the correct vocabulary when searching.
- Patrons can browse, search, and refine subject terms within the Subjects Authority interface. Includes options to view broader, narrower, and related terms for each subject.
- If a patron is researching “business ethics”, they can use the Subjects Authority to confirm that “business ethics” is a valid subject term in EBSCO and then use that term to refine their search.

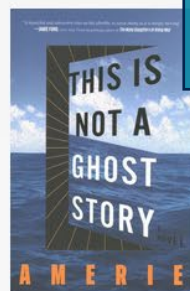

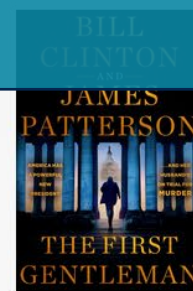
