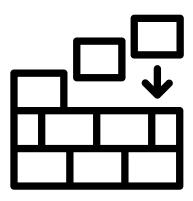

Today's indexing issue (11/25)

- Abnormal ADUtext
 - Add, Delete, Update
- Ticket has been opened with SirsiDynix
- Report any records encountered that has error message or can't be found via Title or ISBN.
- Title control number can be found in Aspen



What's happening?

- Rebuilding the Headings and Text DB indexes
- Beginning Wednesday evening (11/26)
- Anticipate delays to regularly scheduled Symphony Reports on Thursday (11/27)
- SWANcom will be sent prior to and after scheduled maintenance has concluded

Important notes:

- WorkFlows <u>will not</u> be available during the system maintenance

 - My Account features may be briefly unavailable during start of maintenance window

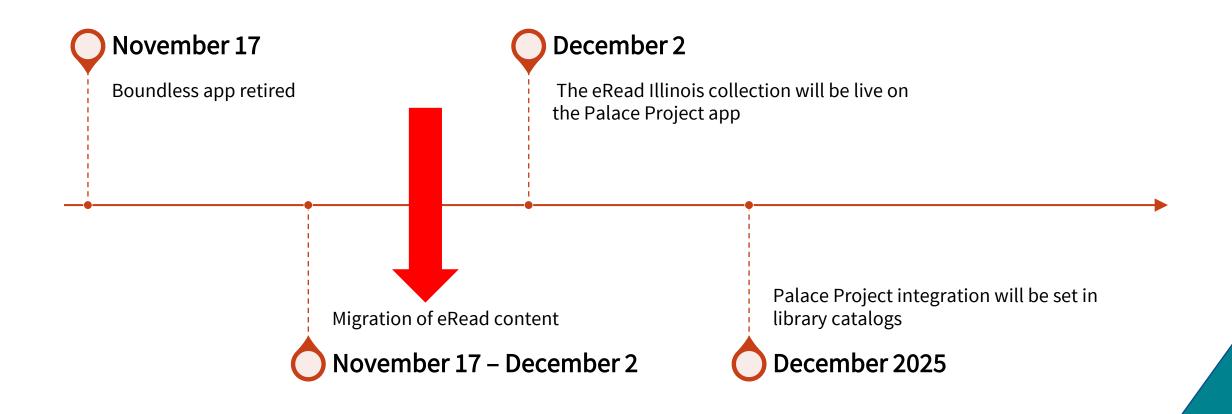
Boundless/Palace Project update

Transition from Boundless to Palace Project

Due to the abrupt closure of Baker & Taylor, the Boundless app will be sunset in the coming weeks. To maintain access to the eRead collection, the eRead team selected Palace Project, managed by Lyrasis, as the new platform.

- Current eRead subscribers will each receive their own instance of Palace Project.
- SWAN is collaborating with Lyrasis to get these instances set up and integrated.
- Palace Project can include additional e-content from vendors such as OverDrive and OCLC CloudLibrary.

List groups

You can organize your lists into nested groups.

This could be useful for libraries with many lists to maintain.

Your Lists Summer Reading (2) Summer Reading

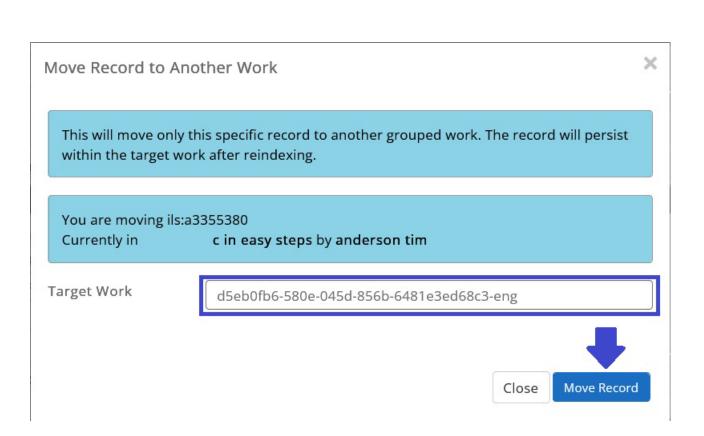


Record grouping tools

You can now move records between groups.

Updated documentation at Aspen Discovery > Grouped Records in Aspen

Note: Only those with OPACCAT permissions can group or move grouped records.



Filter from a keyword search

Note: This is not live in production

Keyword searches that include formats, audience, and other terms can be configured to apply filter.

For example, "new kids picture books about science" could apply filters for:

- Publication date in the past year
- Audience of juvenile
- Subject of picture book

DUX and Cataloging Working will have a special meeting to review an initial configuration.

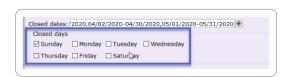
Documentation Reminder

Days Closed Calendar

Method 1: Add recurring, individual, and consecutive dates

If your library is closed on recurring days:

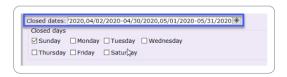
- 1. check the box(s) under Closed days.
- 2. Click Save.



- For example, if you are closed every Sunday, check Sunday.
- Actual dates will not appear in your list when choosing this option.
- If you are closed every Sunday during the summer, enter each date separately so they appear in your list.

Add a date:

- 1. Click in the Closed dates box.
- 2. Find the right place using your keyboard arrow keys.
- 3. Add your date.



Dates must be entered in chronological order.
Use the mm/dd/yyyy format.
Add a comma between dates without spaces.

Weeklies Page Updated for 2026

- Titles on the weeklies list evaluated
 - Serials staying as weeklies:
 - 2026 record created
 - Serials no longer designated as weeklies:
 - 2025 record updated to be full serial record
 - All previous years for periodical merged into full serial record
