
- Tie individual symbols to group Web Services key (through OCLC Developer Network)

- Conversion tables and exceptions








Comparing catalog generations



Reality of comparison

Latest run 1.95% of total holdings added 492,456/25,200,366

Titles/Items not in previous generation (adds)
Few as percentage of total catalog, acquisition of new titles by library




Latest run 1.47% of total holdings deleted 369,836/25,200,366

Titles/Items not in current generation (deletes)
Very few – lost items, weeding by library



OHM Process



OHM future development

- Working with OCLC to increase speed and parallel processing of web services calls
- Web interface
- Reporting tools
 - Invalid identifiers
 - OCLC number cross-references
- Statistics portal







Holdings drive scope display







Holdings determine patron-initiated ILL









Challenges and side notes

Changes in core OCLC discovery ecosystem make constant testing and reconfiguration necessary


- WorldCat Discovery v2
- WorldCat.org work underway

- Keep up with release notes
- Office hours are helpful (taking advantage of OCLC office hours, offering internal for members)



Deflection policies

- Universal deflection policy for SWAN member-to-member requests
- Some libraries deflect outof-state due to cost
- Some libraries deflect based on format






Real-time Availability

- Configured Z39.50 access to catalog (configured by OCLC)
- Saves staff time
- Helps requesting libraries

 more quickly routes to a
 library that can fill request





Refining OPAC status

- Use OPAC Statuses to further automate "no"
- Deflection based on publication date is often not precise for indicating "new" material





Custom Holdings Groups/Paths

- Custom Holdings Group for:
 - Illinois consortium partners
 - Academic network in Illinois
 - All Illinois libraries
 - Preferred/reciprocal lenders
- Custom Holdings Path for:
 - Public libraries, based on closest delivery
 - Academic & Special libraries
 - Preferred






Resource Sharing Buttons

Default settings:



Others further restrict patron-initiated requests.




Remote Authentication





Use IFM

- More of our libraries are setting IFM preferences
- Using IFM as a "bank" to store funds to support requests from patrons that may incur a cost.
- Greater ease in processing lost material and damages through IFM with other libraries.





Internal workflow consistency

- All items being sent out (lending) are checked out to in-house accounts (either OCLC-In-State or OCLC-Out-State)
 - This allows us to consistently report activity across the consortium
- Incoming items (borrowing) from OCLC libraries
 - Create temporary/brief bibliographic record
 - Place hold on patron's record
 - Check in item when received, hold is trapped, patron notified
